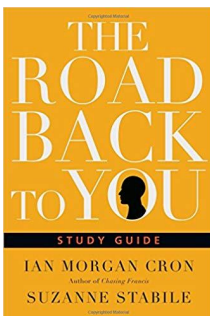


The Road Back to You: An Enneagram Journey to Self-Discovery.

The book study will happen at St. Paul's (in the double classroom on the lower level) on the first and third Thursdays of the month beginning in October, starting [at 7:00pm](#).

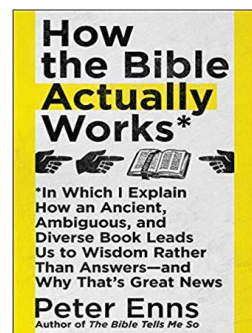
It is my hope that this will be the beginning of a new Enneagram related small group.
