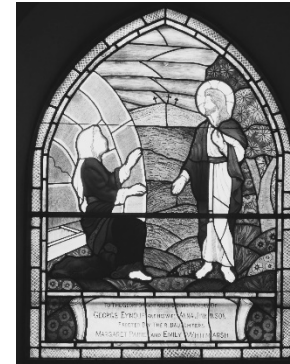

To those who - planted flowers/weeded; took water samples to the Health Unit; cleaned bathrooms, the rectory and hall; baked; organized fund-raisers (Christmas Bazaar, Shrove Tuesday Supper, God Has Got You Covered, Suppers, Plant Sale, raffle baskets); offered themselves to sit on Parish Council; sang in the choir served at the altar; cleaned the church; cooked; set-up tables; washed dishes; arranged flowers; set the altar for Eucharist; attended church meetings, cleaned brass; shoveled the front steps/path to the hall/rectory; organized bulletin dates/events; took down the old garage; prepared site for new shed/met contractors/got quotes for all upgrades to church/rectory; installed shed; managed thermostat settings; weekly logged in donations/took offerings to the

bank; managed finances; received and paid bills; met with the corporation to project the budget; prepared reports; took minutes at Parish Council and Vestry; led Morning Prayer; donated/took food to Lanark County Food Bank and supported other outreach activities; attended bible study; took recycling to the salvage; looked after church/rectory/property maintenance; catered funeral, birthday, and club receptions; cut grass/cared for cemeteries; created/maintained our website and social media; hosted Fellowship after service; sent cards; contributed to the newsletter; chaired Parish Council; filled in the dry well; supplied/spread gravel on the driveway; removed dead tree limbs; bought grocery cards; organized Sunday Readers/Greeters/Fellowship; corresponded with CCA's sponsored children; kept Parish database up-to-date; sent newsletters/emails; kept cemetery records and worked with families as needed; hosted coffee for clergy and after Morning Prayer; were Greeters on Sunday; attended Vestry; plowed snow from rectory/church; visited and phoned shut-ins/took Communion; cleaned out the Rectory; installed new sound system; painted the new shed; shared in weekly work at the Community Gathering Place, United Church; read the Readings and Psalms on Sundays; supported the church and came to Services - THANK YOU.
