

Parish Council Summary – Tuesday, June 20

Service times. Rev. Kerri explained the vote on service times was split evenly between 9:00/9:30 and 10 and so invited Council to discuss and vote on new service time. We will move indefinitely to 9:30 a.m. as of Sunday, July 2.

As Treasurer, Lois provided an update that a response to our request to access funds from our CTF should be received by the end of June or early July.

Financially, we are in good shape. We have paid the Diocese up to the end of May and the transfer of accounts approve by Vestry is ongoing.

As Chair of Property Committee, George Margita offered an update on the status of current renovations and repairs: the church roof, rectory front porch, and the well have been completed. Other projects are pending Diocesan approval of funding. Emergency repairs to the kitchen drain are complete.

Gerd noted the shed is paid for and awaiting gravel from Cavanagh for installation. Staining will be done by us.

A vote was held to approve Lois Lohmann, Colin Price, Henry Troup signing authority, with Gerd Lohmann acting as a fourth signature until a People's Warden is elected. It was agreed the Treasurer is always to have signing authority.

Cemetery Services will be held at Prospect Cemetery at 2:30 p.m. on August 6; Christ Church following the 9:30 a.m. service on August 20.

Rev. Kerri committed to producing a first newsletter by early July that can be sent to our occasional and peripheral community members.
